Please be aware of the following common violations:

**Sec. 7-2002 (b)** Garbage cans and dumpsters shall be removed from the curbside no later than dawn on the day after the scheduled pickup. Garbage cans and dumpsters shall be stored in the rear of the property or as close to the rear as possible on the side of the property to reduce its visibility from the public right-of-way.

**Sec. 7-7003 (1)** Trash and debris

**Sec. 7-7003 (3)** Open Storage

**Sec. 7-7003 (4)** Tall grass and weeds

**Sec. 7-7003 (b)** Parking in yard

**Sec. 10-2033** "Junk Motor Vehicle" shall mean any vehicle which is without current registration, without current tag, or which is one or more of the following:

Wrecked

Dismantled

Partially dismantled

Inoperative

**Sec. 10-2034 (8)** Major Auto repair

**Sec. 10-4001 (2)** Working without a permit

**Sec. 8-1009.1** Obstruction of sidewalks, gutters and streets

It shall be unlawful for anyone to put any obstruction of any kind including grass cut lawns, tree trimmings, tree leaves, household goods, furniture, trash or debris on any sidewalk or in any street or street gutters or any public right-of-way for more than forty-eight (48) hours and it shall be the duty of the superintendent of the code enforcement department of said city to enforce this section by prosecuting anyone violating its provisions in the city court of said city.
